The President's Message

The latest Board Meeting of the Executive Estates of Boynton Beach Homeowners Association, Inc. (Citrus Glen) was held on December 27, 2005 at 7:30 P.M.. Even though the meeting was not well attended, we had excellent input and interesting participation from the floor. The Property Manager reported the progress or lack of progress in the recovery of the community from the last hurricane. We are still trying to get service providers to come to evaluate the damage and to give us quotes to do the work. The tree trimmers seem to be specially difficult to get. Some providers want to charge per "work day" until the job is finished. We are not willing to contract with on open charge and continue to look for contractors willing to commit to a specific amount.

I was informed that the City of Boynton Beach has stated that they would be willing to approve, under certain circumstances, the replacement of wood fences with chain link fence and bushes. One member though that it may be a good idea to replace our existing fences with a chain link and bushes because it would perform better during a hurricane. The majority of the people present disagreed with that concept and was very vocal against the idea. As far as the Board is concerned, that idea is a dead issue. Changing to a chain link fence would be a significant change to the structure of the community and it would require a membership approval. If the members present at the meeting are representative of the majority of the members of the community, the idea would never obtain the votes required to approve the change.

At the end of the month on Tuesday, January 31, 2006 the annual meeting of members will be held. We will be electing three new directors for the period 2006 and 2007. I ask you to please attend the meeting or at least send in your proxy so we have a quorum to conduct business. Last year we had a quorum problem. Please make sure that

it does not happen again this year.

Proxy preparation

To provide a proxy, please use the proxy form sent to you in the mail by APM.

Fill in your Lot No. and address.

Fill in the proxy designee area. If you leave blank the area on the line above the "Print Name of Proxy Designee," the proxy will automatically go to our secretary who will vote on your behalf. If you choose to give your proxy to a specific person, make sure that the person is going to attend the meeting and fill the name of that person on the line above the "Print Name of Proxy Designee." That person will vote on your behalf.

Example:

(Bob Moreno, Harry Wagner or other designee name, not your name)

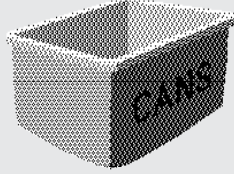
Date the form and again put your lot number.

Sign the form.

The form has to be signed by the designated person to vote. If there is only one owner, the owner needs to sign the form. In case that there is more than one owner. The designated owner will sign the form. If the owner is a company, partnership or a corporation, the designated person needs to sign the form. Print the name of the person signing the form and either send it in the envelope provided to you by APM or deliver it to the person you are giving the proxy to. It is very important that we have at least 59 voting members (30% of 195 FLS 920) attending the meeting in person or by proxy so we can elect the new directors. 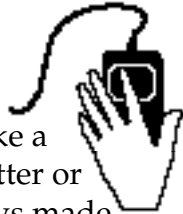

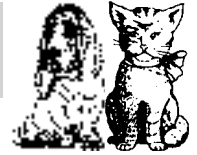

*Dogs: 1.) It shall be unlawful for any dog to be off the owner's property (which property is exclusive to the owner and does not include common areas) unless the dog is under the restraint or control of a person by means of a chain, leash or other device or is sufficiently near its handler to be under his direct control and is obedient to that handler's commands or is caged/crated.
2.) It shall be unlawful for an owner to tie, chain, tether or confine by electronic/radio device a dog on the owner's property within five (5) feet of public property, public access, easements, common grounds or the property of another without the consent of the owner of such property*

The state, County, City and Community require that dogs be on a leash and some one to clean up after them.

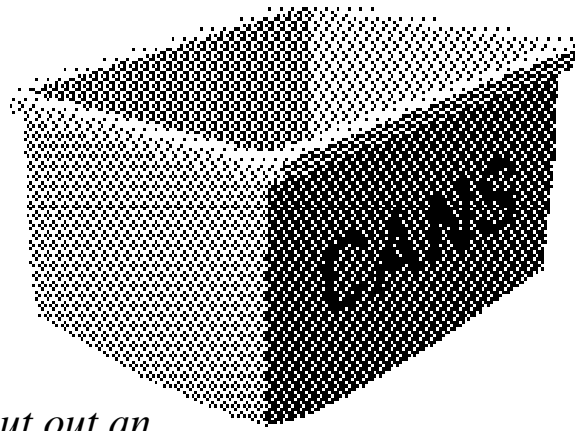

Tire Amnesty and Vegetation Amnesty will be the weeks of June 5 – 9, 2006 and August 28 – September 1, 2006. Please keep your tires and vegetation separated and in accordance with the following guidelines:

Tires – Residents may put out up to eight (8) car and/or passenger truck tires (with or without rims) at the curb for pick-up on their scheduled bulk trash day.
